## **OCCUPATIONAL INJURIES AND ILLNESSES**

Any time you suspect an injury, illness or need first aid treatment, you must report for medical evaluation to ensure that you receive prompt treatment, early intervention, and proper documentation for work related concerns. Per OSHA, it is your right to report without retaliation.

- Medical Emergency: Call 9-1-1 (landline) or 321-867-7911 (cell phone), 321-853-0911 (CCAFS)
- First Aid/Non-Emergency:
  - 1st Shift (0700 1530, M-F) Report to the Occupational Health Facility (OHF), building M6-495
  - · Other shifts, including weekends call 911
- Please be aware of the risks associated with personally transporting individuals to the OHF. Their condition could require emergency medical assistance/actions during transport.
  Please use the 911 services.
- Notify your supervisor/manager at the first opportunity.



## **OSHA RIGHTS**

- Employers are required to provide a workplace free from recognized hazards AND comply with all applicable OSHA standards.
- It is illegal for employers to discriminate or retaliate against a worker for using their rights under the law.

## **VOLUNTARY PROTECTION PROGRAM**

- KSC is an OSHA VPP STAR Site.
- The OSHA Voluntary Protection Programs (VPP) recognize employers and workers in the private industry and federal agencies who have implemented effective safety and health management systems and maintain injury and illness rates below national Bureau of Labor Statistics averages for their respective industries. In VPP, management, labor, and OSHA work cooperatively and proactively to prevent fatalities, injuries, and illnesses through a system focused on: hazard prevention and control; worksite analysis; training; and management commitment and worker involvement. VPP participants are re-evaluated by OSHA every three to five years to remain in the programs. VPP participants are exempt from OSHA programmed inspections while they maintain their VPP status.



# **STOP WORK AUTHORITY**

- When unsafe and/or unhealthful work environment, condition or act pose imminent danger to personnel or damage to property, ALL employees have the right and obligation to exercise "stop work authority."
- Work with management to determine how to eliminate/mitigate the hazard.
- Notify your organizational safety office or NASA Safety at 7-SAFE.
- Refer to KSC-UG-2804 for additional reporting options.



# HAZARD WARNINGS AND CONTROLLED AREAS

- KSC is a multi-user work site with processes for the coordination of essential personnel, special badging, and controlling hazardous and operational areas. Facility/Area/Equipment controls prevent unnecessary exposure of personnel to hazards in and around activities and operations. Area warnings, signals, signs, tags and barricades are used to identify hazards and controls.
- Do not remove or alter signage or devices used to indicate a control.
- Entrance can only be authorized by the controlling authority. Do not attempt to access facilities/areas that you are not authorized to enter. If unsure, contact the Facility Manager or operations control desk.









## **ADVERSE WEATHER**

#### Lightning

- Phase I Lightning Watch Lightning conditions may exist within 30 minutes in Lightning Hazard Notification Area. Employees should implement lightning safety plans/procedures.
- Phase II Lightning Warning Lightning is imminent or occurring. Employees should take action to protect themselves from lightning dangers:
  - Remain indoors
  - $\cdot\,$  Stay away from open doors, window, metal pipes and sinks
  - · Do not handle combustible or flammable liquids
  - If inside a vehicle with a solid metal roof and sides, stay inside the vehicle
  - · If caught outdoors, get to a safe location as quickly as possible

#### Hurricane Conditions (HURCONs)

- HURCON IV Sustained winds of 58 mph or greater within 72 hours
- HURCON III Sustained winds of 58 mph or greater within 48 hours
- HURCON II Sustained winds of 58 mph or greater within 24 hours
- HURCON I Sustained winds of 58 mph or greater within 12 hours

#### Tornados

- Tornado Watch: Conditions are favorable for tornadoes.
- Tornado Warning: Seek shelter. Tornado/waterspout is imminent or occurring.






# WILDLIFE

- KSC is on the Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge.
  - · All wildlife and nests are protected at KSC.
  - · Please do not touch, feed, disturb or handle any wildlife.
- Obey speed limits, for your safety and the safety of wildlife.
  - Report all wildlife encounters that have the potential to impact personnel or operations to the KSC Duty Office at 321-861-5050.
  - If you are bitten/scratched, report to the OHF for evaluation or call 9-1-1 if the injury is serious.

When using a mobile device, the quickest way to receive emergency services is to dial KSC or Cape Canaveral 911 directly.

- Step 1: Take out your mobile device and open the camera app (or QR Code Scan App)

- Step 3: Save each contact into your phone
- Step 4: If on KSC, use "KSC 911", if on the Cape use "Cape Canaveral 911"
